PRAYER | God, show me your heart for those around me.


CONTENT: VIDEO | *EVERYDAY EVANGELISM*

Go to bit.ly/WCMenHW2 to watch the Everyday Evangelism videos. Then answer the following questions. Bring a printed copy of your answers to the next session.

- What stood out to you from the videos?
- Why is it difficult to talk about our faith with others? What would cause you to become interested in someone else's faith? What would it take for you to feel comfortable talking with them?
- What is your reaction to the "Five Thresholds"? Do you feel like this path reflects your own faith journey?
- What is one insight you hope to remember?

ASSIGNMENT | *YOUR ONE*

Who is your "one"? As we talk about our influence with those around us, it can be helpful to think about who we interact with the most. Fill in the circles around "you" with the groups of people with whom you frequently interact (e.g., coworkers, neighbors, gym acquaintances, parents of your kid's teammates). As you consider these circles, share the name of at least one person who doesn't have a relationship with Jesus.



If that one person was curious about your faith and asked you to tell them about it, what would you say? Type a one-page response of how you would respond to this person's questions: "What does being a Christian mean? What is so good about it?"

For some of us, this assignment can be a struggle. That's okay. For others, the general idea of what to say might come easily, but think about how you would respond in a real-life way, not as a "project to convert" but as a person you have a relationship with. If it's helpful, type your exact wording as a conversation.
